

The monthly meeting of the Elgin Town Council was held Tuesday, October 2, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. at the Elgin Town Hall with Mayor Brad Hanley presiding. Councilman Risvold was absent.

Invocation was given by Councilwoman Emmons and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilman Ernst.

Mayor Hanley recognized the new business licenses:
