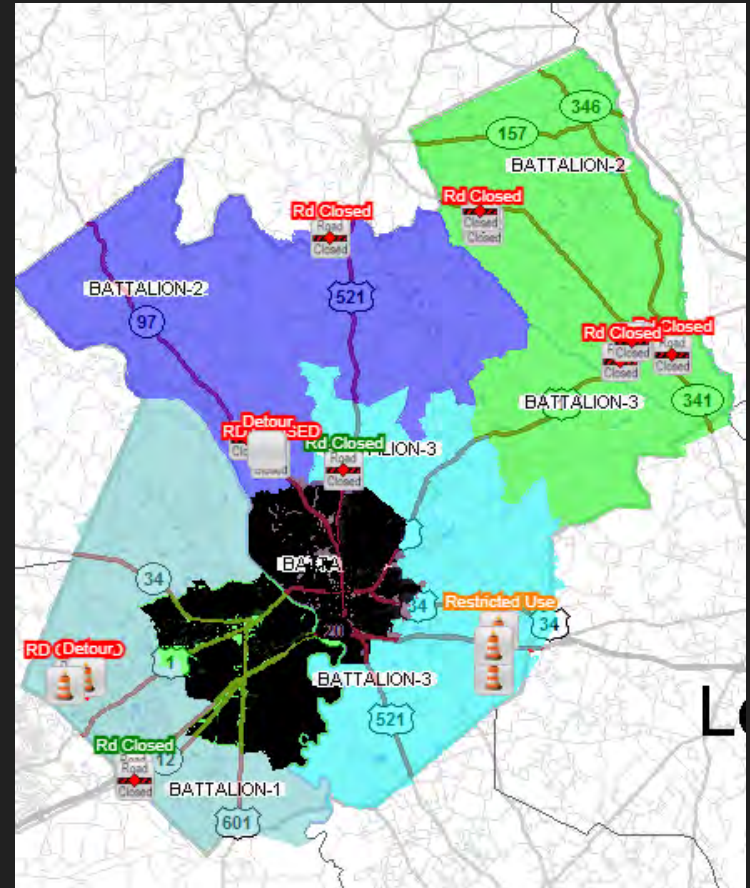

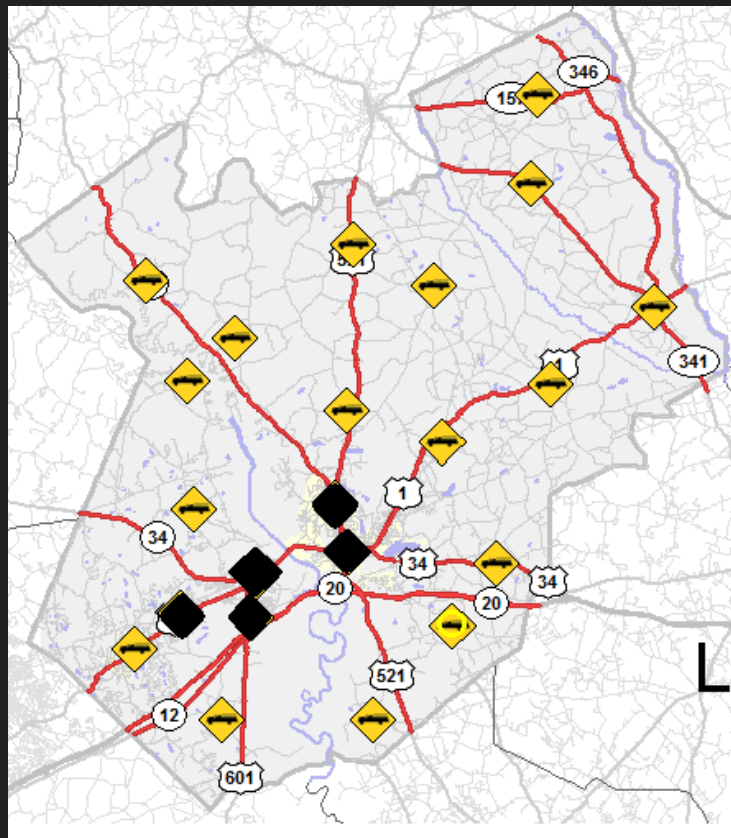
KCFS

- 120 Volunteers



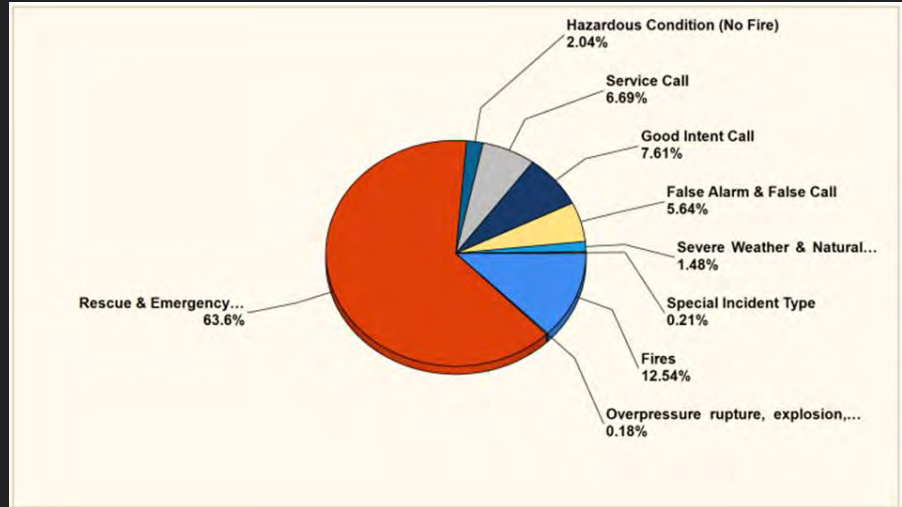
Rank Structure
