An Ordinance to Provide for Special Election Dates & Times

WHEREAS THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ELGIN WILL HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR ONE TOWN COUNCIL SEAT, AND

WHEREAS SAID ELECTION SHALL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 28, 2023, AS REQUIRED BY THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA. THE TIME FOR THE ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON THE FOLLOWING DATES AND TIMES:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

- 1. The election shall be held on March 28, 2023. Polls shall open at 7:00am and close at 7:00 p.m. Polling places shall be Blaney Baptist Church at 1400 Blaney Road, Elgin, SC 29045 for registered voters residing in Precincts Elgin 1, and Elgin 3, and at Stover Middle School at 1649 Smyrna Road, Elgin, SC 29045 for registered voters residing in Precincts Elgin 2, Elgin 4 and Elgin 5.
- 2. The filing for One (1) Council position will commence at noon on January 30, 2023 and close at noon on January 30, 2023.
- 3. Town Council authorizes the running of the announcement for Election in the paper of local coverage, placed Sixty (60) days prior to the Election and at least one other time.
- 4. Candidates and voters must reside within the Town Limits of Elgin to participate in this election.
